

Eligibility Guidelines

- Age 21-64 for **Cervical Screenings**; Age 40-74 for **Breast Screenings**;
- **Meet Current Income Guidelines** (*less than 250% of poverty level*);
- **Uninsured or Underinsured** (a deductible/co-pay of \$250 or more); and
NOT a Medicaid and Medicare Part B recipient
